The Ethos AI Registry is independent civic infrastructure — a neutral, public-interest standard for documenting the AI systems shaping everyday life. It is not a regulator and not a vendor. It is the connective tissue between people building AI, the communities living with its outputs, and the institutions responsible for oversight.

Public interest groups need structured, verifiable records to hold systems accountable. Researchers benefit from a standardized corpus of disclosures, audits, and reported harms. Government entities require consistent evidence to draft, enforce, and evaluate AI oversight.
